Winemaking

After a very special ripening, the grapes were harvested and the must chilled. After cold maceration for about a week, fermentation took place at controlled temperatures and the wine remained on skins for about three weeks. The wine was filled in French casks and aged for more than 24 months until bottling.

Tasting Notes

A deep purplish red color, with a scent of blueberry jam and wild strawberries and hints of vanilla and cloves, full-bodied and rich.

Serving suggestions

Excellent with well-done roast beef, lamb stew or lamb, and roast duck.

Family of Wine

In the Old City of Jerusalem, the Shor family founded Israel's first recorded winery in 1847. Now, over 170 years later, the seventh and eighth generation manage the fifth largest winery in Israel. Hayotzer Winery marries the tradition of Israel's foremost wine family with the creativity of one of Israel's finest winemakers.
