Ch Valandraud 1st GCC) and the Roussillon. It also carries a large range of carefully selected wines from Bordeaux sold in exclusivity as well as the major Bordeaux Classified Growths.

Informations techniques

Soils: Clay and Limestone

Grapes : 80% Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc

Production: 18 000 bottles

Tasting notes: is drinking wonderfully; dark berries and smoke are underpinned by a vein of tannin. This is a modern wine, ideal for traditional roast beef.

Average age of the vines: 35 years

Ageing: 12 to 18 months in oak barrels: 1/3 in new oak, 1/3 in 1 year barrel and 1/3 in barrel of 2 years.
