

# Château Tour Labatut

## A.O.C. Montagne Saint-Emilion



*Given the nickname « the Bad Boy » of Saint-Emilion by Robert Parker, Jean-Luc Thunevin has managed throughout his career to become little by little a central figure of the exclusive Bordeaux wine industry.*

*In 1988, Jean Luc Thunevin created his own wine merchant company THUNEVIN SAS, which handles the distribution of Jean Luc Thunevin's wines from Bordeaux (incl. Ch Valandraud 1st GCC) and the Roussillon. It also carries a large range of carefully selected wines from Bordeaux sold in exclusivity as well as the major Bordeaux Classified Growths.*



On the most eastern quarters of Entre-Deux-Mers, the Château is most certainly one of the most beautiful residences of a region renowned for its architectural wealth. Once the demure of the Seigneurs of Duras, it was built during the Hundred Years' War. Two impressive defence towers dating back to the 15th century frame the castle's elegant architecture.

### Informations techniques

**Soils:** 45 hectares Clay and Limestone

**Grapes:** 80% Merlot, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon & 10% Cabernet Franc

**Production:** 30 000 bottles

**Tasting notes:** Ruby robe with purple highlights. Its nose is characterized by ripe fruit (strawberry, black cherry and blueberry). Its full mouth, with dense, silky tannins has a lovely finish.

**Average age of the vines:** 30 years

**Ageing:** In new oak barrels for 1 year
