Winemaking

The Swing is an enchanting melody of Syrah and Mourvèdre from Kfar Tabor, complemented by Barbera. This blend is aged in barrels for 9 months, allowing it to develop an intricate and captivating complexity that promises to evolve over the next 7 to 10 years.

Tasting Notes

Radiating strawberry and black cherry hues, Swing offers an enticing nose of sweet spices and rosemary. On the palate, this medium-bodied wine presents a notable oak presence and round tannic structure, with the Barbera adding an enticing layer of complexity.

Serving suggestions

Pair this nuanced blend with robust dishes like grilled lamb or beef stew to elevate every meal into a gourmet experience.

Family of Wine

In the Old City of Jerusalem, the Shor family founded Israel's first recorded winery in 1847. Now, over 170 years later, the seventh and eighth generation manage the fifth largest winery in Israel. Hayotzer Winery marries the tradition of Israel's foremost wine family with the creativity of one of Israel's finest winemakers.
