Immerse in the delicate dance of the Danza Waltz, a vibrant symphony of Viognier, Gewürztraminer, Marsanne, and Chardonnay that waltzes across your palate with a rich, full-bodied, and tropical melody, inviting a gastronomic exploration from sea fish to cheeses.

Hayotzer is a quality driven winery situated on the outskirts of Jerusalem. Each wine is a personal statement of its creator (Hayotzer in Hebrew), the renown French born winemaker Philippe Lichtenstein.

Winemaking

The Danza Waltz is an intricate blend of Viognier combined with Gewürztraminer and Marsanne from Kfar Tabor, and a touch of Chardonnay. This composition, devoid of woody influences, delivers a wine that is rich, full-bodied, and with a remarkable presence.

Tasting Notes

Bathed in a light, pale yellow hue, the Waltz greets the senses with floral notes and tropical touches of melon and kiwi. Its palate resonates with a good acidity, and a full-bodied richness, creating a mouthfeel that is satisfyingly substantial.

The Waltz pairs beautifully with a wide range of dishes. Enjoy it with the subtle flavors of fish, poultry, or contrast its tropical and floral notes with a variety of cheeses.

Family of Wine

In the Old City of Jerusalem, the Shor family founded Israel's first recorded winery in 1847. Now, over 170 years later, the seventh and eighth generation manage the fifth largest winery in Israel. Hayotzer Winery marries the tradition of Israel's foremost wine family with the creativity of one of Israel's finest winemakers.
