This wine is the Galilee version of the famous Côtes du Rhône blend of Grenache, Syrah, Mourvedre.

Hayotzer is a quality driven winery situated on the outskirts of Jerusalem. Each wine is a personal statement of its creator (Hayotzer in Hebrew), the renown French born winemaker Philippe Lichtenstein.

Winemaking

Each plot was harvested at full maturation. The Grenache was harvested first, then the Syrah and finally the Mourvedre. The wine of each grape variety was made separately and aged for 8 months in oak barrels. Later, the blend was made and the final wine was aged for an additional 14 months in oak.

Tasting Notes

A delicate dry red wine with aromas of ripe red fruit and Mediterranean spices, it is smooth with a long finish.

Serving suggestions

Pairs well with lamb, sausage, pastas and Provencal
