The famous Bordeaux blend from the finest Upper Galilee vineyards. This wine got great reviews from wine journalist around the world.

Hayotzer is a quality driven winery situated on the outskirts of Jerusalem. Each wine is a personal statement of its creator (Hayotzer in Hebrew), the renown French born winemaker Philippe Lichtenstein.

Winemaking

Each vineyard was harvested at night, at full maturation. The Merlot was harvested at the end of August, Cabernet Sauvignon two weeks later. The Cabernet Franc and Petit Verdot were harvested last, in the middle of September. The wine was blended after the components were oak aged.

Tasting Notes

A dry red wine with intense dark fruit aromas, strong and dense with good acidity and woody notes.

Serving suggestions

Pairs well with braised beef or Ragout, barbecue.

Family of Wine

In the Old City of Jerusalem, the Shor family founded Israel's first recorded winery in 1847. Now, over 170 years later, the seventh and eighth generation manage the fifth largest winery in Israel. Hayotzer Winery marries the tradition of Israel's foremost wine family with the creativity of one of Israel's finest winemakers.
