A great fruity Cote de Rhone style Syrah, with strong body and generous mouth feel. Great as food accompaniment.

Hayotzer is a quality driven winery situated on the outskirts of Jerusalem. Each wine is a personal statement of its creator (Hayotzer in Hebrew), the renowned French born winemaker Philippe Lichtenstein.

Winemaking

The fruit was sourced from a beautiful vineyard near Mount Tabor. The grapes were harvested before dawn and after cold maceration, aged for 18 months in a blend of American and French oak barrels.

Tasting Notes

A dry red wine with black plum and violets aromas, accompanied by notes of smoked vanilla. This wine has a strong body and a generous mouth feel.

Serving suggestions

Pairs well with roasted sheep, sausages and beef daube Provençal, as well as poultry such as duck and quail.

Family of Wine

In the Old City of Jerusalem, the Shor family founded Israel's first recorded winery in 1847. Now, over 170 years later, the seventh and eighth generation manage the fifth largest winery in Israel. Hayotzer Winery marries the tradition of Israel's foremost wine family with the creativity of one of Israel's finest winemakers.
