The Pasco Project series wines are fashioned from established and emerging vineyards of ultra premium terroir to deliver fruit forward varietal flavors married with maturation in classic 225 liter French oak casks. The wines are unrefined and minimally filtered, designed to reflect the winemaker's firmly held belief that fine wines are created in the vineyard.

GRAPES

60% Marselan, 20% Petit Verdot

OAK MATURATION

9 months barrel ageing in a mix of European oak barrels from selected coopers.

WINEMAKERS NOTES

The 2019 Pasco Project Winemaker's Blend presents Pasco's first production of a Marselan varietal based wine. The succulent fruity nature of the Marselan grape, with higher acid and low tannin profile, is ideal for the production of a decidedly European aroma and flavor profile, reminiscent of the elegant medium bodied red wines of central and Northern Italy. This wine pairs well with a diverse range of dishes from classical, elegant pastas like fettuccine alfredo and lasagne to rich succulent roasts like lamb. The resulting wine has a classic "European" mouthfeel and length. Enjoyable at release, the wine will continue to gain complexity, smoother mid-palate flavors, and a longer aftertaste with extended bottle aging.
