Winemaking

The grapes were harvested at full maturation. After crushing, destemming and cold-soaking, the fermentation process began at a controlled temperatures. Following three weeks of maceration, the wine was filled into barrels. This wine was blended from the best barrels of this vineyard.

Tasting Notes

A dry red wine full of blackcurrant aroma. It is strong with a smooth lingering finish of vanilla and cloves.

Serving suggestions

Pairs well with red meats and lamb.
