Winemaking

The grapes were night harvested at full maturation. After crushing, destemming and cold-soaking, the fermentation process began at a controlled temperature. Following three weeks of maceration, the wine was filled into French-Oak barrels.

A dry red wine full of cherry and blueberry flavors, well balanced with a rich structure.

Perfect with duck, turkey and beef daube.
